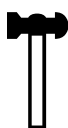

MEMBERS shall comply both in spirit and letter with rules and regulations prescribed by law and governmental agencies for the health, safety and progress of the community.

MEMBERS shall not perform, or cause to be performed, any act which would tend to reflect on, or bring into disrepute, any part of the building industry.
